

## THE PLANTS OF MYAKKA RIVER STATE PARK

The wide variety of habitats (ranging from wet marshes to well-drained scrubby flatwoods) throughout Myakka's 37,000 acres support a diverse and interesting flora. This list includes 743 species of native and non-native (exotic) plants and was compiled from a collection of plants made primarily over the past fifteen years.

We hope this list, used with plant guides and keys such as those listed in the recommended references, will help you better know the fascinating plants of Myakka River State Park.

### USING THIS PLANT LIST

This list is arranged alphabetically by family. Each entry of genus and species is followed by the plant's common name (if available), growth form, frequency of occurrence and the habitats in which it occurs. A notation is also made for Not native and listed species. The list is followed by an index of genera, common names, and families.

*Nomenclature:* Nomenclature follows Wunderlin and Hansen (2003). Note that some family names have changed because of the updated classification system. For example, Hypericums are now classified in the family Clusiaceae. So if you cannot find a familiar family, check the index to locate the plant by the common name or genus.

*Common Names:* Every effort has been made to locate common names for as many plants as possible. This list uses common names from *Checklist of the Vascular Plants of the Florida Sun Coast*, the references on the following page and names in common use by local plant enthusiasts.

*Abundance:* Terms used to describe species abundance are rare (seen in only one or two localities), infrequent (seldom seen), occasional (present in scattered locations), common (usually present), and abundant (always present). Frequency designations are based on observations by the collector and refer to the plant's abundance in its most common habitat rather than park-wide occurrence. Other habitats in which the plant occurs are also listed.

Plant communities: The classification of communities of vascular plants used here follows *Ecosystems of Florida*. If the Florida Natural Areas Inventory (FNAI) equivalent differs, it follows in parentheses.
