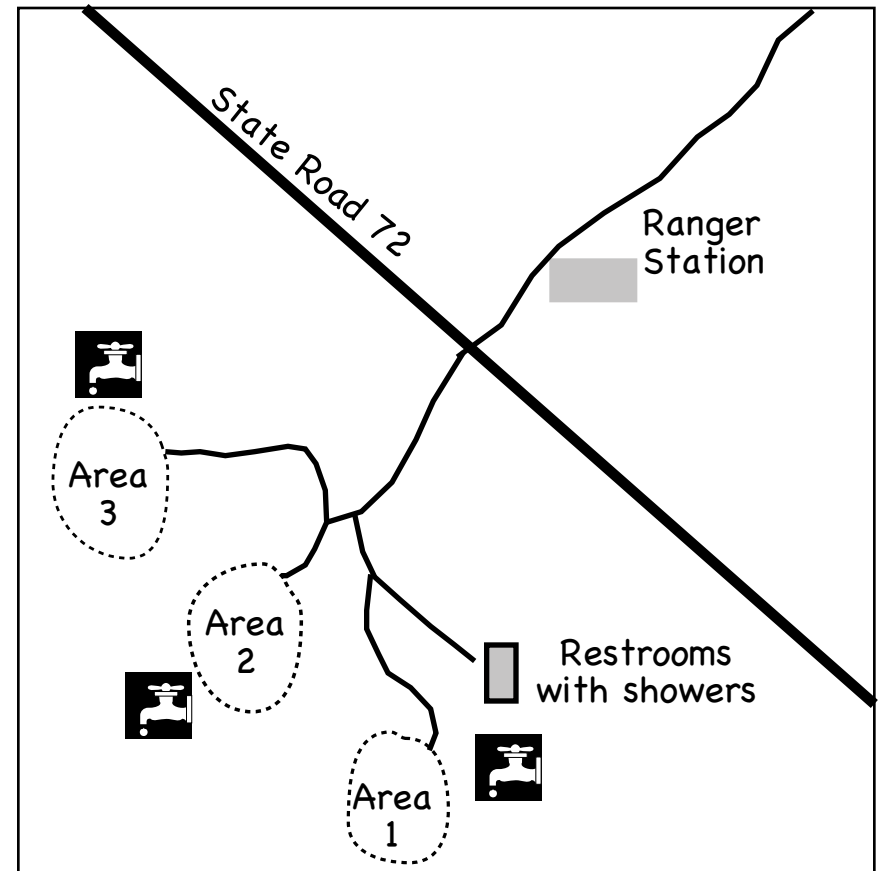

Youth/Group Camp Information

This area is for organized adult or youth groups. An organized group is defined as six or more persons affiliated with a recognized non-profit or community organization such as Scouts, Boys & Girls Clubs, Sierra Club or church groups.

- * Priority is given to youth groups (groups with over half of members under 18 years of age).
- * Each site accommodates up to 20 people.
- * Youth camp areas are rented on a first come, first served basis unless reservations are previously made with the park by telephone or in person.
- * Reservations are accepted up to 30 days in advance for adult groups. Reservations are accepted up to 6 months in advance for juvenile groups.
- * Arrival time must be prior to sunset, unless arrangements are made with park ranger on day of arrival.
- * Checkout time is 1:00 P.M. unless otherwise determined by park management.

Fees

Adults	\$2.00 per night
Youths (over 5 years)	\$1.00 per night

State sales tax is charged unless tax-exempt number provided when registering to camp.

Park Regulations

In order to insure the protection and wise use of the park, all campers are requested to follow these regulations.

One chaperone (21 years or older) must accompany each 10 youths or fraction thereof and must remain with the group at all times.

One ax or hatchet permitted per site or group. No saws or machetes please.

Firewood may not be gathered within the park.

All plants are protected. Do not cut, bend, break or deface. No ropes, lanterns or other articles hung on trees, please.

Fires - Campfires in the designated areas only.

Sanitary facilities - Use park restrooms. No temporary latrines or pits allowed.

Garbage - Place in garbage cans - do not bury or burn.

After Dark - Youth campers must remain in camp after dark unless accompanied by adult leaders. Quiet hour is 11:00 PM.

Pets are not permitted in the youth camp area.

All animal life is protected. Do not feed, remove or molest.
