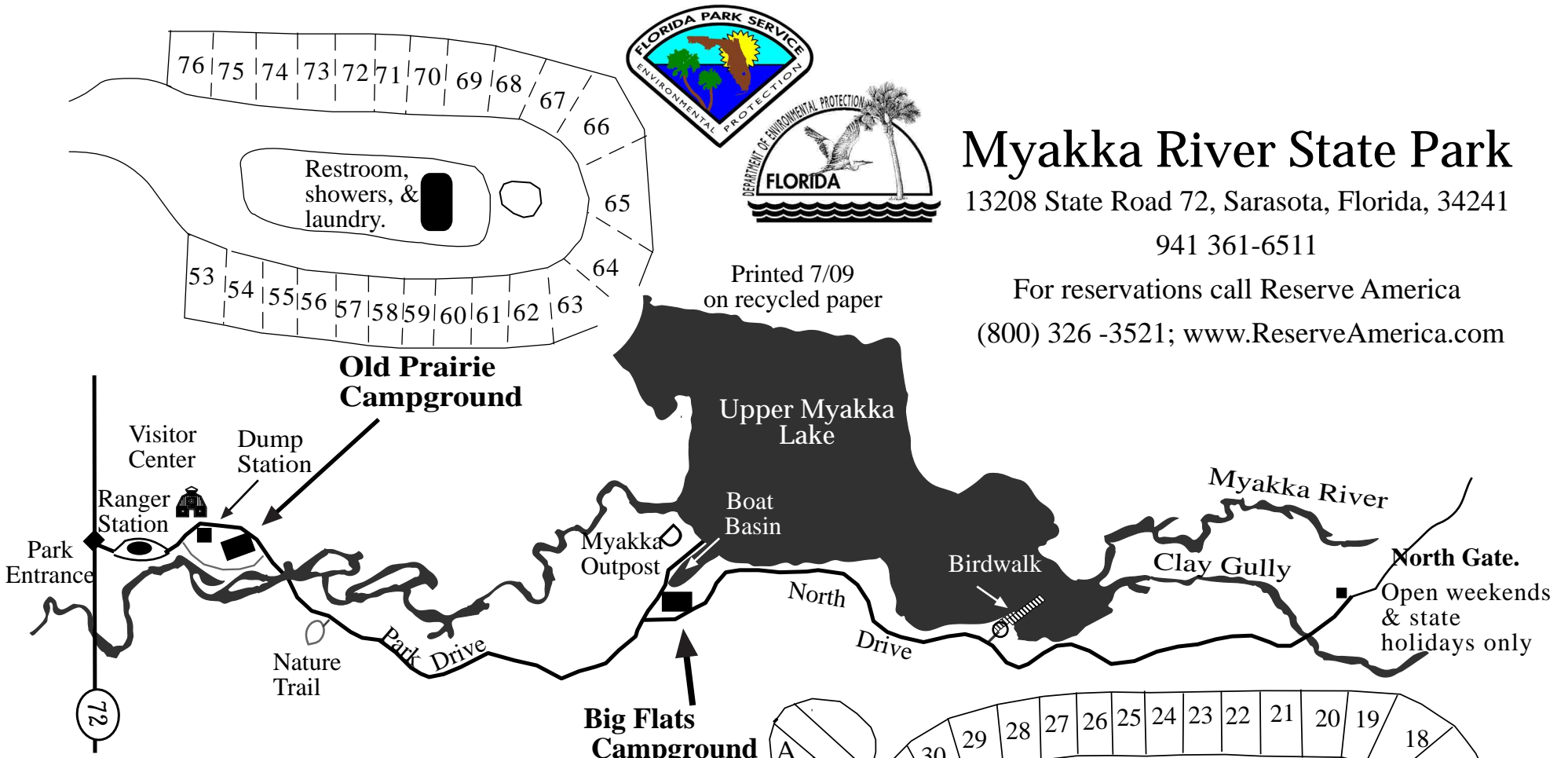

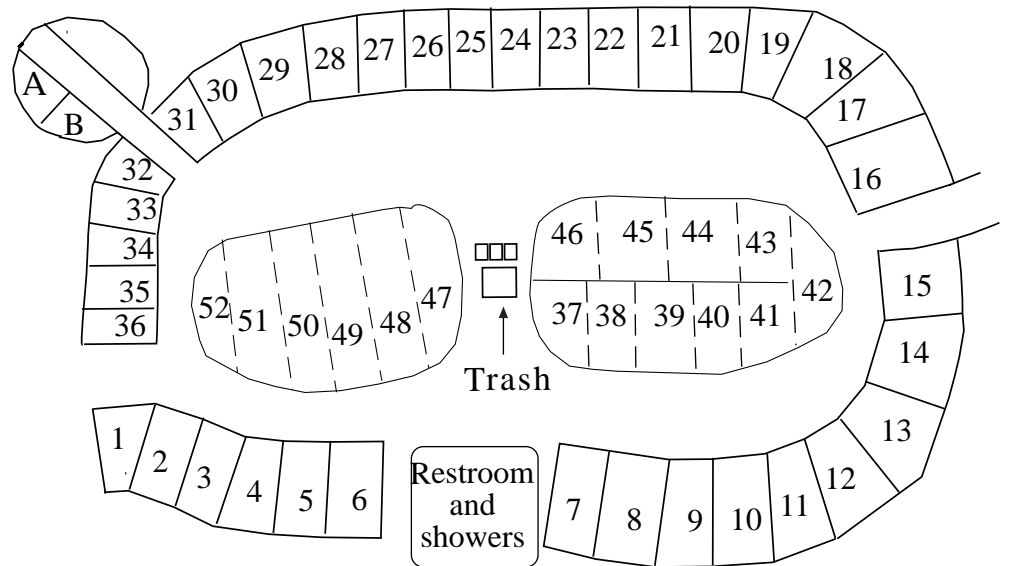

### Distances from Ranger Station.

- Cabin Road and Old Prairie Campground .....0.3 miles
- Nature Trail & Canopy Walk .....1.0 miles
- Big Flats Campground .....2.8 miles
- Outpost Concessions and Boat Dock.....3.0 miles
- Bird Walk .....5.0 miles
- North Entrance Gate .....7.0 miles



## **Please keep these things in mind while camping at Myakka River:**

Park only in your assigned campsite. Any other site may already be rented or reserved. Maximum site occupancy is 8 persons. Camping rigs must not encroach on adjoining sites. 2 small tents (4 man) or 1 large tent per site (8 man).

Please do not place ropes, nails, clotheslines, or lanterns on trees. Dispose of gray water properly. Dispose of food scraps in dumpster. Please do not feed the animals or leave food unattended. Bug light zappers are not permitted in the park. Build campfires in grills and fire circles only.

Firewood may not be collected.

Quiet hour is 11:00 p.m. No generators, televisions, radios, or loud noises after 11:00 p.m.

Check-out time is 1:00 p.m. Deposit windshield sticker in box in exit lane by ranger station.

Pets are permitted in the campground, but not in cabins, restrooms, or other buildings.

**Emergencies:** Dial 911 for sheriff, ambulance, or fire. Park Rangers after hours, call 941 373-7270 , 941 923-4282, 941 373-7271, 941 376-4503, 941 923-1931, 941 925-3149, or 941 232-9560.

## **Where to find it...**

**Dump station**—is just south of Old Prairie Campground and north of the log cabin restroom.

**Telephones**—are located outside the Ranger Station and in front of the park concession.

**Park programs schedule**—is posted at ranger station and on campground bulletin boards.

**Brochures**—at the Ranger Station (park programs, fees, animals, plants, birding, trail maps, Florida dry prairie, fire, hiking & biking, cabins, horse trails, 25 Things to do, and other Florida State Parks.

**E-mail download station**—There is a phone line for email downloads available at *Myakka Friends Gallery and Gifts* in the ranger station between 3:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. daily.

**Washers and dryers**—are located at Old Prairie Campground by showers.

## **Reservations**

**Cabin or Family Campground reservations** accepted by phone (800 326-3521) or on-line (<http://www.ReserveAmerica.com>) up to 11 months in advance. Prepayment by MasterCard, Visa, or Discover Card is required. Sites accommodate up to 35-foot RVs. Make reservations at least one day in advance.

**Group camp or primitive backpacking** campsites reservations are made at Ranger Station. Call 941-361-6511.
